

Photovoltaic system in operation: milestone on the road to energy independence

We are pleased to announce the successful commissioning of our new photovoltaic system. With the gradual installation of over 1,000 solar panels on seven rooftops at the company head-quarters in Sevelen, we have taken a significant step towards true energy independence. The system has an impressive total output of 317 kWp and will generate around 317,000 kWh of environmentally friendly electricity.



In order to optimise the use of the solar energy generated, a powerful energy storage system with a capacity of 556 kWh was also installed. This storage system makes it possible to store surplus energy and retrieve it flexibly when needed. As a result, we can not only increase energy efficiency, but also significantly reduce our dependence on external energy sources.

With a planned total output of an impressive 317,000 kWh, we will be able to cover a significant proportion of our electricity requirements ourselves.

This not only represents an important step towards sustainability, but is also an important statement for the future of our company.
